Certified Used Vehicle Program

Your certified used vehicle has met the minimum required mechanical standards as set out by The Driving Force Inc. Certified Used Vehicle Program. These minimum standards are:

- Minimum 60% remaining tire tread
- Minimum 50% remaining brake life
- Free of major visible body damage
- Free of interior damage greater than 2 cm
- Free of major cracks and/or separations in belts and hoses
- Free of all fluid leaks
- Free of windshield cracks
- 2 sets of keys
- Operator's manual

Warranty Program

The Driving Force Inc. provides a 3 month or 5000 kilometer* power train warranty.

**Whichever passes first.*

Your power train warranty includes:

Engine

All internal lubricated parts, manifolds, expansion plugs, harmonic balancer, pulleys, engine mounts, oil pan, rotary engine rotor housing, factory installed supercharger/turbocharger housing internal parts, vanes, timing belt/chain and tensioner, timing chain cover, valve cover(s), water pump, metal cooler lines, hoses with metal/alloy pressure fitting attached, seals and gaskets within component group. Cases, housings, engine block and cylinder heads are covered only if damaged by the failure of an internally lubricated part.

Drive assembly (front-wheel and rear-wheel drive)

All internal lubricated parts within the drive/transaxle assembly including, axles and axles bearings, constant velocity joints, constant velocity boots, drive axle housing, drive shaft support, differential cover, hub bearings, front locking assemblies, drive shaft, universal joints, four wheel drive actuator, seals and gaskets.

What isn't covered:

- A. Failure due to misuse, alteration or lack of proper maintenance.
- B. Failure caused by collision, fire, theft, freezing, vandalism, or explosion.

- C. Failure caused by lightning, earthquake, wind storm, hail, water or flood.
- D. Failure caused by racing or other competition.
- E. Failure caused by pulling a trailer of another vehicle unless your vehicle is equipped as recommended by the manufacturer.
- F. Any cost covered by warranty or otherwise covered by the manufacturer or a repairer's guarantee.
- G. Any cost incurred to improve operating performance due to normal wear and tear of engine, transmission and front/rear wheel drive assemblies. This includes, but is not limited to, valve or ring repairs designed to improve engine compression or reduce oil consumption.
- H. Economic loss including loss of time, inconvenience, lodging, food or other incidental or consequential loss or damage that may result from a failure.
- I. Storage charges.
- J. Any repairs if the odometer has been disconnected, stopped or changed.
- K. Any repairs if the vehicle warranty has been voided for any reason.

The following are excluded from coverage:

- A. Vehicles used for business travel by more than one driver on a regular basis.
- B. Vehicles rented to someone else.
- C. Vehicles used for livery, limousine, hearse, delivery of parcels or goods, snow plowing or as a taxi.
- D. Vehicles used as a police car or other emergency vehicle.
- E. Vehicles rated over 13,500 lbs (6125kg) GVW.
- F. Vehicles used as a tow truck or vehicle carrier.
- G. Vehicles altered from original equipment manufacturer's specifications.
